




Seating Location


The safest position for this booster seat is in the centre rear of the back seat. Do not use the front seating position unless there is no rear seating position available and there is a tether strap mounting position behind the front seat. See page 10


Always use the tether strap

Booster seat must sit **firmly back** against the vehicle seat.






Airbags




Only use with a combined lap and sash belt


DO NOT use with a Lap only seatbelt

SIP open door side only




Top Tether Strap


Always connect the snap hook securely to the anchorage fitting.
See page 15.



To increase webbing tension pull upper strap through adjuster.
See page 15.




To release webbing tension press adjuster button and pull lower strap.
See page 15.




Do not pull so tight that the booster seat is lifted off the vehicle seat.
See page 16.




Store end of web in bag on back of cover.
See page 15.



Straps must not be twisted.
See page 16.



Check tether is tight.
See page 16.



Check

1. Snap hook securely attached to anchorage.
2. No twists in straps.
3. Tether is tight.
4. End of web is in storage pocket


Checklist

Headrest adjusted to suit the child's height.
See below and page 10

IMPORTANT: a sash belt under the arm or behind the back is dangerous

CORRECT SASH BELT PATH


Sash belt must pass through the red guide in the headrest.
Label shows correct path




BOOSTER SEATBELT PATH

CORRECT VEHICLE BELT PATH

Belts pass under armrest. Label shows correct path




Vehicle Belt securely latched



No hot, sharp or heavy objects in cupholder


Sash belt must make good contact with the child's chest.
See page 11

Lap belt passes over the child's upper thighs, not across the stomach.
See page 11




Size of child

Child's shoulders must be between the dotted lines when seated. See page 9



Headrest position


Bottom of headrest close to top of shoulders



How to adjust headrest

UP squeeze adjustor

DOWN squeeze adjustor



Sides become wider as headrest raises.
