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Introduction

This product is PSC and SG mark certified.

About the SG mark system



This is an abbreviation for "Safety Goods" and was established by the Consumer Product Safety Association. This mark is displayed only on products recognized as meeting the SG standards, which stipulate the necessary requirements for safe products, regarding items that may pose a risk of harm to life or the body based on their structure, materials, usage, etc.

SG mark

• Cribs displaying the SG mark meet the following standards.

Scope of application	This crib is a single-person crib intended for use in ordinary households for the sleep or care of infants.
Classification	Infant/toddler crib
Scope of use	Newborn (*) up to 24 months.
Floorboard height	Upper section: Newborn to when able to stand while holding onto something (generally 5 months or more after birth). Lower section: Around the time when able to stand while holding onto something (generally 5 months or more after birth) to 24 months old. * Please be careful not to let your child fall when using the lower level. * For infants from newborns up until when they are able to stand while holding onto something, please do not use the lower level, as there is a risk of them falling when being laid down.

(*) A newborn is an infant with a gestational age of 37 weeks or more and a birth weight of 2.5 kg or more.

About the child PSC mark



PSC stands for "Product Safety of Consumer Products," and products that pose a high risk of causing significant harm to the life or body of consumers cannot be sold unless they bear the PSC mark, indicating conformity with the technical standards established by ministerial ordinance.

PSC mark for specified children's products

• Cribs displaying the child PSC mark comply with the technical standards for specified products for children and the labeling requirements regarding usage precautions such as target age, as defined by ministerial ordinance.

About indications

If handled incorrectly, there is a potential for death or serious injury.

- Do not use for children over 24 months of age.
- Please do not use if you are not the intended user. This may lead to unexpected accidents or injuries.
- When putting your child to sleep, please lay them on their back until they are 1 year old.
- Please take care to ensure that strings or similar items on children's clothing do not get caught on the crib posts. There is a risk of your child choking.
- Please ensure there are no gaps between the bassinet and the mattress or bedding. Also, please use a mattress or futon that has appropriate firmness. There is a risk of unexpected accidents, such as suffocation or injury, to children.
- This product is designed and manufactured with sufficient safety considerations to withstand the required weight. However, please avoid using it in the following conditions.
 - Use while the travel Cot's locking component is not fully secured at the top.
 - Use without laying down the included dedicated mattress.
- When your child is able to pull themselves up to stand (generally 5 months of age or older), please lower the mattress to the bottom position so that the height from the top surface of the mattress to the top rail is at least 60 cm. There is a risk that a child may climb over the top rail and fall.
- Install the crib on a horizontal, level surface, and do not use it near heating appliances. This may result in falling over, burns to children, or fire.
- Always use within sight of a guardian and do not leave the child unattended.
- Please do not place any objects on the outside or inside of the crib that a child could use as a foothold. There is a risk that children may climb up and fall.
- Please do not attach unnecessary items such as strings or cords to the crib as they are dangerous. There is a risk of your child choking.
- Do not sit on the edge of the crib, hang from, or shake the crib.
- Do not use if damaged, malfunctioning, etc.
- Do not use with two or more people at the same time, and do not hang from the top rail. There is a risk that a child may climb over the top rail and fall.
- Please ensure that the mattress is attached to the travel Cot in a flat state. There is a risk of your child suffering unexpected accidents, injury, or suffocation.
- When using a mattress or futon, please take care that it does not create a height that allows the child to easily climb over the top rail.
- Do not place the crib near blind cords or curtains. There is a risk of your child choking.
- Do not use vinyl sheets, mattress covers, etc. There is a risk of your child choking.
- Do not place items that pose a risk of injury or suffocation inside the crib.
- Please do not modify the crib.
- Do not use the crib for any purpose other than your child's sleep or childcare.
- Do not place children under the bassinet.
- Please do not move the crib while your child is in it.
- If the mattress gets wet, please let it dry completely before use. It may deform under load, which could lead to unexpected accidents.
- The crib you are using is designed for children up to 24 months of age, but since children around one year old are active, please be very careful to prevent them from climbing over the top rail.

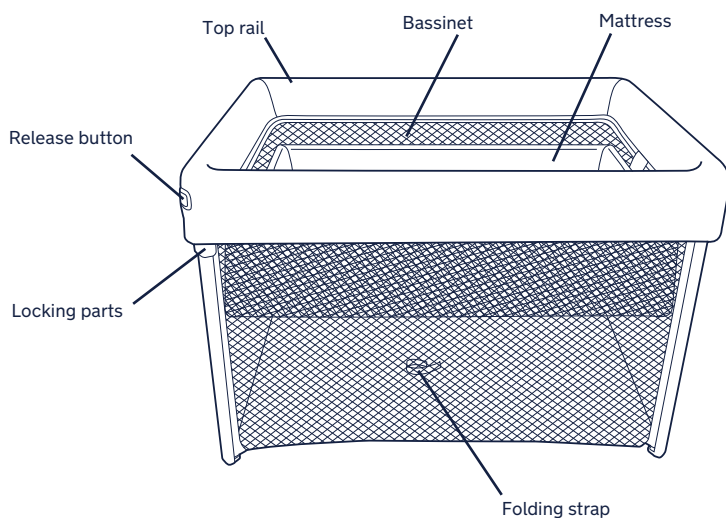

- Do not use a water mattress with this product. There is a risk of unexpected accidents involving children.

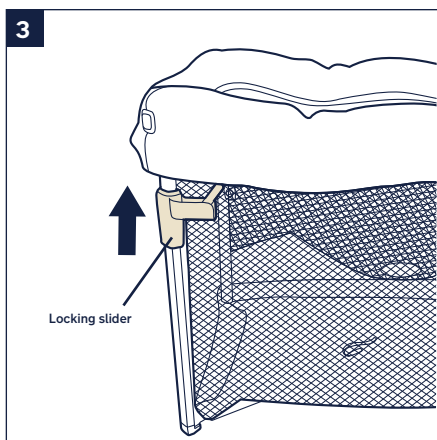
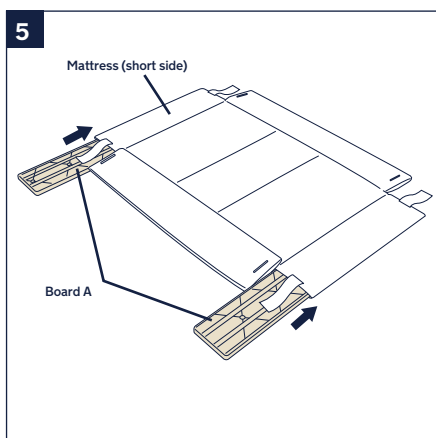
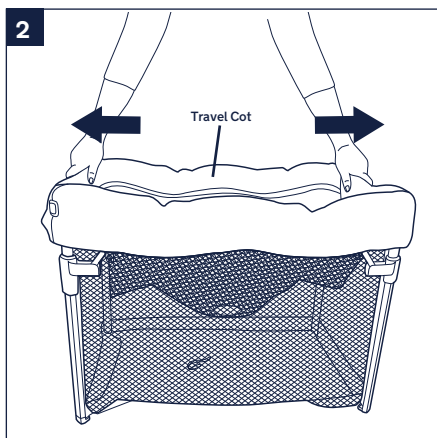
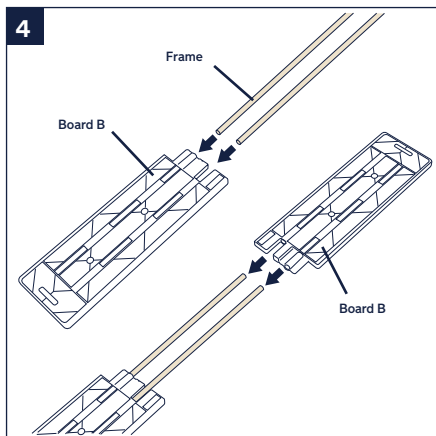
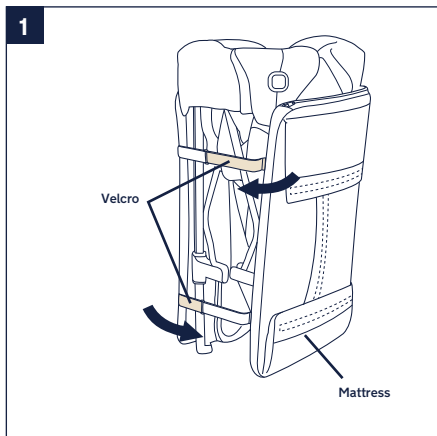
How to assemble Travel Cot

⚠ Warning: Please make sure there are no children around.

- 1 - Undo the 2 Velcro strips on the mattress and take out travel Cot.
- 2 - Please open travel Cot.
- 3 - Please raise until the slider is secured.

⚠ Warning: Please ensure that travel Cot is securely fixed.

- 4 - Insert the frames (2) into Board B, and insert Board B from the opposite side. (Total 2 items)
- 5 - Insert Board A into the short side of the mattress. (Total 2 locations)



How to assemble the crib

- 6 - Please insert Board B into the long side of the mattress.

(Total 2 locations)

- 7 - Raise the long and short sides of the mattress, pass the securing bands through the holes in the mattress and board, and secure them with the Velcro. (4 locations in total)

- 8 - Please place the mattress in the bassinet. Please securely attach the mattress's Velcro to the travel cot's Velcro.

 **Warning:** Please make sure that the mattress is securely fixed.

How to adjust mattress height

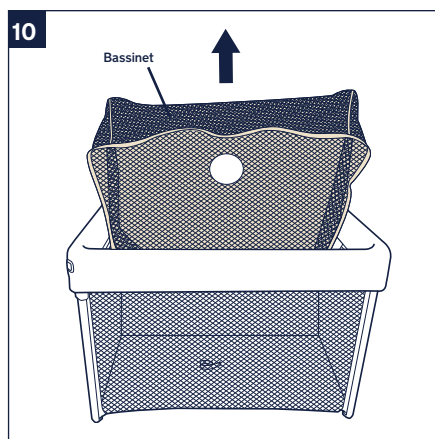
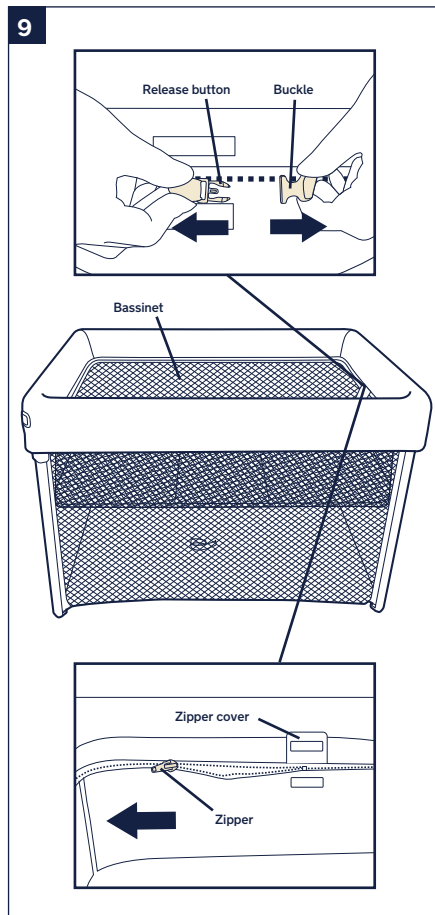
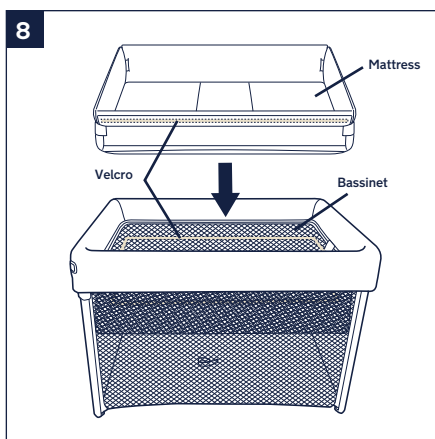
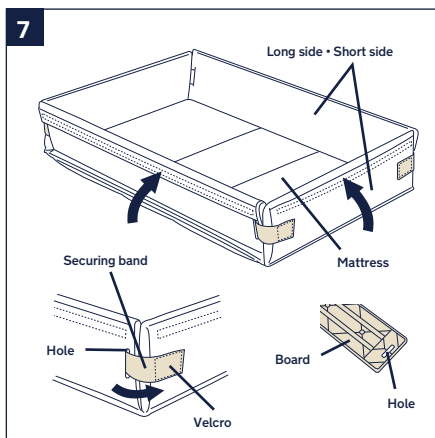
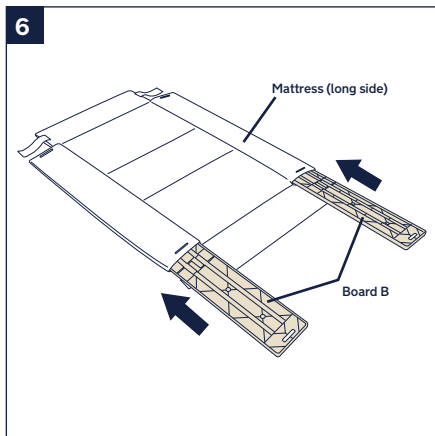
 **Warning:** Once your child is able to pull themselves up to a standing position (generally 5 months of age or older), please lower the mattress to the lowest position so that the height from the top of the mattress to the top rail is at least 60 cm.

- 9 - Please remove the mattress from the bassinet.

Flip back the zipper cover, press the buckle release button, and unfasten the buckle. Please detach the bassinet using the zipper.

- 10 - Please remove the bassinet from the travel Cot.

 **Caution:** Please store the bassinet in a place out of the reach of children.



How to adjust mattress height

- 11, 12 - Please place the mattress on the bottom of the travel cot.
Securely attach the Velcro on the bottom and sides
of the mattress to the Velcro on the travel cot.

 **Warning:** Please make sure that the mattress is
securely fixed.

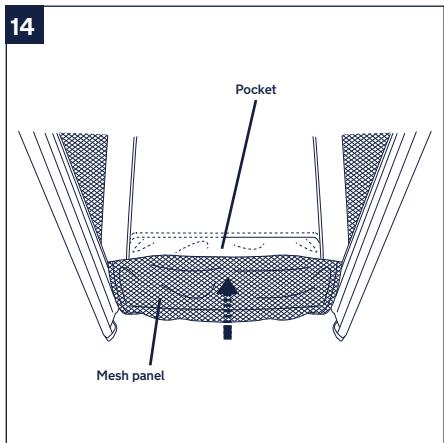
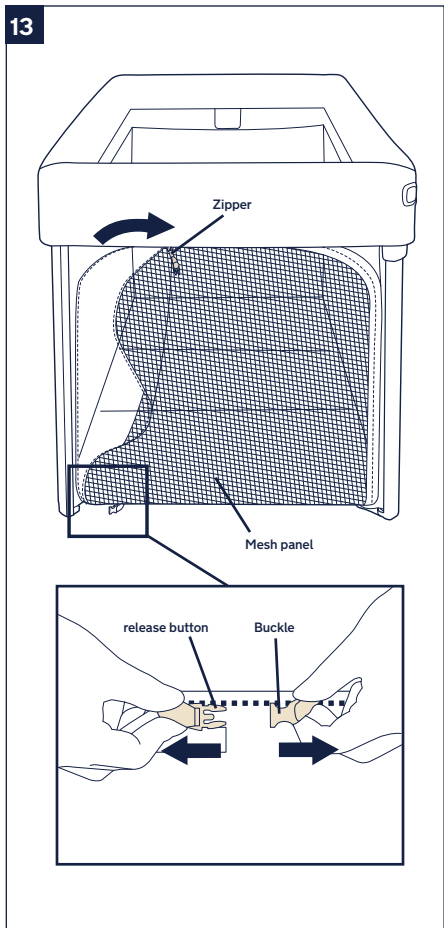
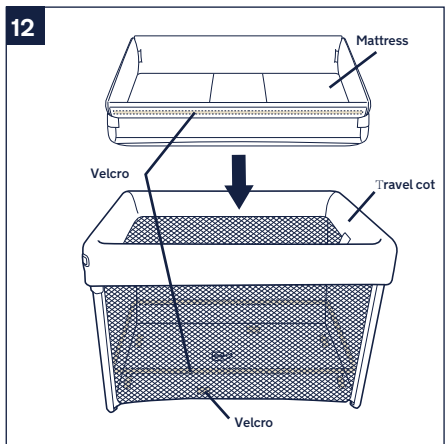
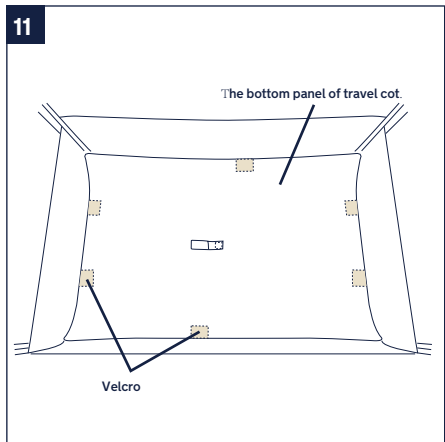
How to open and close the mesh panel

- 13 - Please press the release button to unfasten the mesh
panel buckle. You can open and close the mesh panel
with the zipper.

 **Warning:** When closing the mesh panel, please be sure
to fasten the buckle.

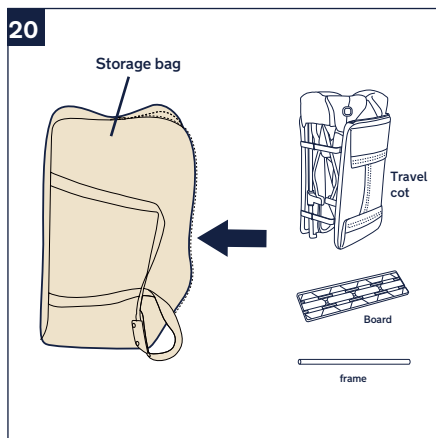
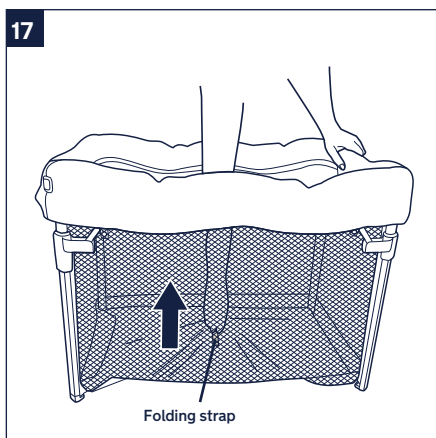
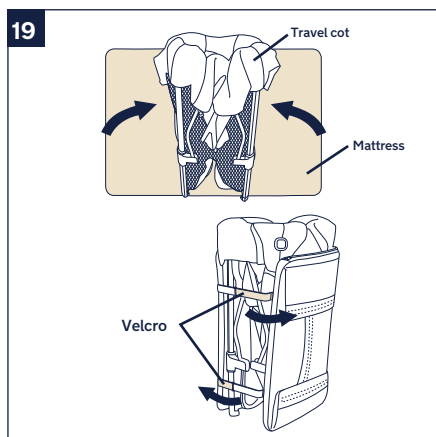
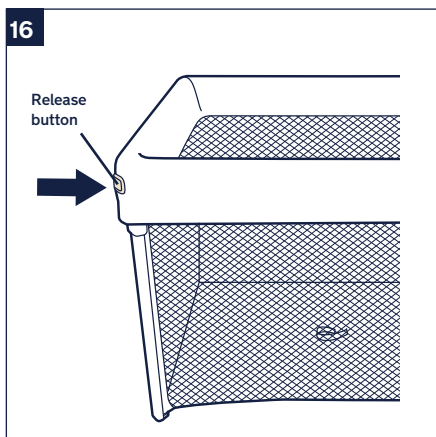
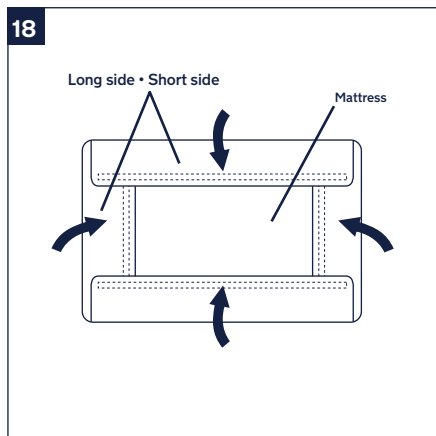
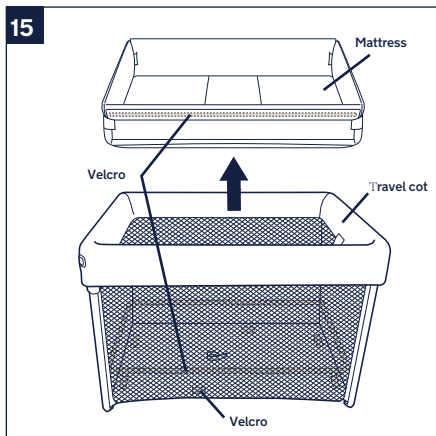
- 14 - Please store the opened mesh panel in the pocket on
the underside of the travel cot.

 **Warning:** Do not open or close the mesh panel when the
bassinet is attached to the travel cot.



How to fold

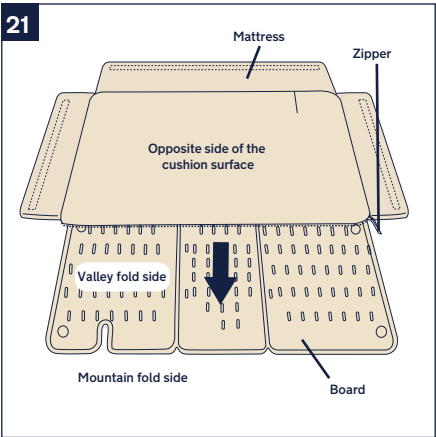
- 15 - Please remove the mattress from the travel cot.
Please disassemble the mattress by following
"Assembly method 4–8 (P7–P10)" in reverse order.
- 16 - Please press the release button on the travel cot.
- 17 - Please pull the folding strap attached to the bottom
of the travel cot to fold it. (Can be folded even with the
bassinet attached.)
- 18 - Please fold the long and short sides of the mattress.
- 19 - Flip the mattress over, place the travel cot on it, wrap it with
the mattress, and secure it in two places with the Velcro.
-  **Warning:** Please pay attention to the orientation of the
mattress. Rolling it in the incorrect direction
may damage the board inside the mattress.
- 20 - Please store the travel cot, board, and frame in the storage bag.



When removing the board from the mattress

21 - When cleaning the mattress, please open the mattress's zipper and remove the board.

⚠ Caution: When using the travel cot, please be sure to insert the board into the mattress. Please also note that the board has an orientation (valley fold/mountain fold).



How to clean the mattress and bassinet



Hand wash at a maximum temperature of 86°F.



Do not use bleach.



Do not tumble dry.



Hang dry in the shade.



Do not iron.



Do not dry clean.

⚠ Caution

- Do not use a hair dryer to dry.
- Please dry thoroughly after washing before use, as there is a risk of mold growth.

Care Instructions

- Do not iron.
- Do not bleach or dry clean.
- Please be aware that fluorescent whitening agents may transfer depending on the detergent used.
- Even with normal use, fading may occur due to sunlight, or damage may occur due to long-term use; this is not a defect.
- Be sure to check that each part is operating normally before use. In particular, be sure to check that adjustments, such as those to buckles, as well as fasteners, are working properly.
- For safety reasons, please use only genuine nuna parts.
- Please regularly check that everything is functioning correctly. If there are any torn, broken, or missing parts, please stop using this product.

Notes on disposal

- Please follow the instructions of your local government when disposing.
- To protect the environment, please do not dispose of this product in places other than the designated area.

About storage

- Place the travel cot in a plastic bag or similar, and store in a cool, dark place away from direct sunlight.
- Please do not expose the travel cot to smog, water, rain, snow, etc.
- Do not leave the travel cot exposed to direct sunlight or in humid places for an extended period.
- Please keep the travel cot in a dry place.
- Do not place any items on top or store in a condition where pressure is applied, as this may cause malfunction or deformation.

About the child PSC/SG mark system

Child PSC mark: cribs bearing the child PSC mark comply with the technical standards for specific products for children and the labeling requirements regarding usage precautions such as target age, as specified by ministerial ordinance.

SG mark: This is a mark displayed only on products that are recognized as meeting the strict safety standards of the Consumer Product Safety Association. This compensates for personal injury accidents resulting from defects in infant cribs. This applies only to the infant crib itself; the mattress, futons, etc., are excluded.

About the SG mark compensation scheme

For products with the SG mark, in the unlikely event that a personal accident, such as an injury, occurs within the validity period due to a product defect, despite the consumer using the product in the correct manner, the Consumer Product Safety Association will compensate for such damages.

- ① Even if the SG-marked product itself malfunctions, this does not guarantee its quality. It is solely for compensating personal injury (medical expenses, etc.).
- ② The items covered by the compensation system are limited to the crib itself; the mattress, futons, etc., are not covered.
- ③ For infant cribs, products within 5 years of purchase are eligible.
- ④ Limited to accidents that occurred within Japan.

<Warranty Provisions>

- This warranty is valid only in Japan.
- If used overseas, this warranty does not apply.
- Although our products are manufactured with the utmost care, in the unlikely event of a product defect, please immediately stop using the product and contact us.

1. In the event of initial failure, or malfunction or damage caused by manufacturing defects under normal conditions of use, we will repair the product free of charge within the warranty period from the date of purchase (or date of delivery). If this warranty card is lost, or the place of purchase is unknown, it will not be covered by this warranty. (Copied warranties are invalid)
2. In the following cases, repairs may not be possible even within the warranty period.
 - If the product is discontinued and the parts necessary for repair are no longer in stock
 - If it becomes irreparable due to unauthorized modification
 - Breakage of wooden parts, peeling of paint, etc.
3. In the following cases, this warranty does not apply, even within the warranty period. When requesting a repair, the customer is responsible for the repair costs and shipping fees.
 - Failure and damage due to customer misuse, or modifications or unauthorized repairs
 - Failure and damage caused by fire, earthquake, flood, lightning strike, or other natural disasters
 - Malfunction, damage, and loss or breakage of parts due to transportation, moving, dropping, etc., after purchase.
 - If the seals affixed to this product have been removed
 - Natural discoloration of wood, aging, UV degradation, cracking of the surface coating due to expansion and contraction, and variations in hue (texture) or paint color due to wood grain or material properties
 - Wear and tear of consumable parts such as tires, inner tubes, valve cores, and wheels
